Photos online – think about this!

- Photos, like anything else on the Internet, can easily be copied by anyone who sees them.
- Photos can be shared easily and instantly with millions of people by email or posting them on Facebook and anywhere really!
- Photos uploaded to the internet can't be removed. For these reasons, you need to be careful about what pictures you upload to the internet, as once you've posted them you can't control who sees them.
